## u5CMS - How to establish a review process

You have to establish a congress web site with your u5CMS having the following properties:

- 1. Enable users to create an account, see "Automatic Intranet Inscriptions" on http://www.yuba.ch/u5cms → Extras > Intranet: Automatic Inscriptions
- Create an intranet page (its name's first character must be an exclamation mark), let's say

## 3. Create a non-intranet page welcoming the reviewers, let's say reviewersaccess e.g

On the next page, THE REVIEW LIST, you will find the link to one or more abstracts to be reviewed. Below the abstract you will find the scales for scoring.

Firstly, the reviewer is logged in, so the system know who is accessing the list.

Secondly, you have to tag each abstract on the formdata2.php table of **!uploadabstracts** as follows (you'll find the formdata2.php table in the u5CMS's backend, there click PIDVESA's S-Radio (see upper right corner of your screen), then the form data-button, then the html-link on the !uploadabstract-row). Now the tagging: in the formdata2.php table enter for each abstract the e-mail address of the assigned reviewer(s) in the Notes-field, each one IN PARANTHESES. E. g.
